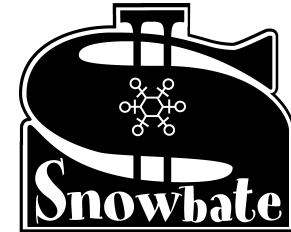

The Snowbate is a program created by the Minnesota Film Board to stimulate more feature film and television series production in the state. The rebate is designed to give producers an incentive to shoot in Minnesota versus a competing market by returning 10% of documented Minnesota production expenditures to them (with a maximum rebate of \$100,000 per project).

Note: Each fiscal year runs from July 1 to June 30. For example, FY 2001 was 7/1/00 to 6/30/01.
